The shape is kept to minimum creating the effect of lightness and spaciousness. The style of Impuls is primarily a contrast between black and white as well as gentleness and clarity. Neutral oak and chestnut colours of the worktop are balanced by the contrasting gloss colours of lacquered desk frame. Cabinets in the appropriate finish combined with a minimal amount of furniture not only organize the office space but also act as considerably important decorative elements.

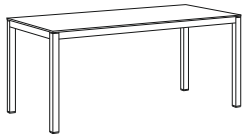


Furniture is produced of light wood and glass, which are connected by the aluminium components.

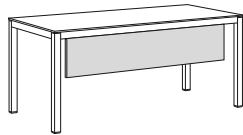
Stylish simplistic design and moderate number of elements add space and vividness to the room.

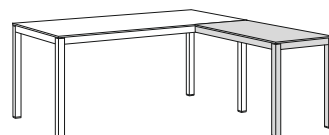
Choosing the right colours is of highest priority. The hues of solid white and black suit the minimalist nature of Impuls and harmonize with glass doors or high gloss HPL.
